

PLANT & HONEY STALL – THE PROCESS

On High Weald's Plant & Honey Stall you can sell your plants and local honey. A commission of 10% payable to Sussex Beekeepers Association will be deducted from the total value of your items sold. Items can be donated and an optional donation to High Weald Beekeepers' Association can also be made at the bottom of the form.

Please **prepare** your items as much as possible in **advance**:

Print and complete the attached form. Attach a suitable label to your plants with your name, the plant's description and the price (eg. Fred Bloggs, Sicilian Tomato, 50p).

Honey needs to be prepared and labelled as per current Regulations. The price will be agreed with the Association Stall holder on the day.

A limited number of Forms and suitable labels will also be available on the day.

Proceeds of the sale less any deductions may be collected in cash from the Treasurer at the conclusion of business or later in the form of a cheque by post, or Bank Transfer.

Small Print

The organisers reserve the right not to accept any items considered to be unsuitable due to cleanliness, condition etc.

All items offered for sale on the Plant & Honey stall and in the Auction remain at the risk of the seller prior to the sale and the buyer thereafter. The organisers can take no responsibility for any items mislaid, lost or stolen.

Sellers are responsible for the removal of any unsold items before the end of the day.

Similarly, buyers will need to remove their purchases from the premises by the end of the day.

The organisers reserve the right to remove uncollected items and pass any disposal costs on to buyer or seller as appropriate.
